WHITE WINES

- 18. Rioja Blanco, Cofrade** *Spain* £19.95
A fresh bouquet, and a fairly full flavoured, full bodied wine made in the traditional white Rioja style.
- 19. Chenin Blanc, Running Duck** *South Africa* £22.50
Organic & Fair-trade accredited. Generally planet-friendly all round - this crisp and fresh wine.
- 20. Gavi, Ca Solare** *Italy* £23.50
Produced from the Cortese grape, dry with well balanced acidity, a lovely lemony palate and a soft fragrant bouquet.
- 21. Pouilly Fumé, Domaine des Fine Caillottes** *France* £35.00
On those chalky hills the Sauvignon grapes give a smell to the wines which is called gun-flint. Particularly good with seafood.
- 22. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** *New Zealand* £39.95
The vines produce intensely flavoured fruit with distinctive varietal character. An elegant, aromatic wine with appealing fruit and crisp acidity.

RED WINES

- 23. Chianti, Sogatia** *Italy* £23.00
A forward and accessible in style, with an aroma of ripe cherry fruit and a soft and fruity palate.
- 24. Zinfandel, 770 Miles** *California* £23.50
A true classic, full of rich ripe plummy fruit, is well flavoured with an excellent bouquet and palate.
- 25. Shiraz, Earthworks** *Australia* £29.50
Delightful Barossa Valley Shiraz. Deep crimson colour with hints of vanilla and cinnamon.
- 26. Fleurie, Cave de Fleurie** *France* £29.50
A soft fruity and inviting wine. Often referred to as the "Queen of Beaujolais".
- 27. Pinot Noir, Domain Road, Central Otago** *New Zealand* £33.50
Soft and aromatic with spicy plum and cherry flavours with a light concentration of seasoned oak.
- 28. Grande Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Los Vascos, Baron de Rothschild** *Chile* £35.00
Superb red as you would expect from Château Lafite – Superior-ness in Chile.
- 29. Barolo, Manfredi** *Italy* £39.50
A better known Italian red. Powerful, slightly oaky with a rich velvety fruity palate.

CHAMPAGNE

- 30. Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royal Brut NV** *France* £39.95
Elegant, with delicate subtle notes of white peach, fresh flowers, dried pineapple and biscuit.
- 31. Laurent Perrier Brut NV** *France* £48.00
Leaning towards a lighter house style, Chardonnay flavours predominate - crisp green apples and citrus flavours - giving the wine good food compatibility.
- 32. Laurent Perrier Brut NV** *(Half Bottle) France* £24.95
- 33. Laurent Perrier Brut NV** *(Qtr Bottle) France* £12.95
- 34. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé** *France* £71.00
Deep coloured, with powerful fruit aromas and delightful taste.
